Oundle School traces its history back to 1556, when Sir William Laxton, a former Lord Mayor of London and Master of the Worshipful Company of Grocers endowed a 'Free Grammar School' in Oundle. Laxton, was born in Oundle and became Lord Mayor during Henry VIII's reign. He used his wealth to fund what became Oundle School. Today it is the third largest independent boarding school in England with over 1050 pupils, of which 835 are boarders. Any references to Laxton in the town (Laxton Junior School etc) are to commemorate Sir William Laxton. **Thanks to Oundle School and Oundle Museum.**
