To assist Anglian Water with the water main renewal on New Road and Glapthorn Road, Oundle Town Council (OTC) agreed to them using part of the Recreation Ground to store their equipment. Along with paying OTC for this use, Anglian Water also agreed to make good any damage they caused to the Recreation Ground.

We're pleased to announce that this work has now been completed. Anglian Water has re-seeded the grass area and as a thank you to Oundle residents they have also resurfaced the basketball court. The resurfacing of the basketball court was on our list to do, so we're pleased with the result, and cost saving to Oundle. We've replaced the basketball net and we're in the process of getting a company to paint the court lines on the floor.

## Speed Report on North Bridge

The speed indicator device has been on North Bridge, picking up vehicles heading into Oundle, since end of November 2023 and during this time over **380,000** vehicles went past. Although the majority of vehicles drove within the speed limit **over a third drove in excess of 30mph, with a small percentage travelling twice the legal limit.** All the data we collect is shared with the Police for their Enforcement activities.
