Anglian Water works on Glapthorn and New Road

Anglian Water started work on Glapthorn and New Road on **3 July 2023** with a scheduled completion date of **5 April 2024**. This necessary work is to resolve two issues;

- To renew the water main along New Road to reduce the amount of burst clusters.
- 2. To increase the flow and pressure into the Cotterstock Road/St Peter's Road area by laying a reinforcement main along Pavilion Drive and 100 meters along Glapthorn Road.
