Advisory 20mph speed limit signs in Oundle

As part of the Oundle Town Council (OTC) Transport Study it became clear that many residents were concerned about speeding as an issue. One suggestion from the Transport Study report and the monitoring data behind it was that a 20mph limit should be encouraged in parts of the Conservation Area, particularly given its high volume of pedestrian traffic.

OTC does not have the power to enforce speed limits, but working in partnership with North Northants Highways, we are introducing a voluntary 20mph limit around the town centre, with an ambition of formalising it in the future. We are also hoping to encourage further voluntary 20mph limit areas around town, for example around Oundle Primary School and New Road, and again, North Northants Highways have been very helpful. An initial tranche of green 20mph speed signs are in position around the town centre, and will be shifted around to create a new impact over the next few months.

Together with another vehicle activated speed sign, we hope to move towards slower traffic speeds around the town centre, and then extend that behaviour elsewhere in town.
