

## **Roadworks are starting in your area soon**

### **What's happening, where and when?**

**What:** Pre-Surface Dressing Carriageway patching - Surface Dressing is a cost-effective road surface treatment used to prolong the life of roads that are starting to show the first signs of minor deterioration. It extends the life of the road surface, increases skid resistance, and seals the surface to stop water ingress, protecting it from damage caused by severe winter weather, such as potholes. Prior to surface dressing, carriageway patching will be undertaken to address any minor issues to prepare the road for the dressing, which will take place in the summer.

**Where:** Oundle Road, Titchmarsh/Thorpe Waterville

**When:** Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> May – Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June (weeknight working only)

**How long:** 9 Nights (22:00 – 07:00)

**Traffic Management:** The road will be closed to through traffic on Oundle Road, Titchmarsh and Oundle Road, Thorpe Waterville. A diversion will be installed during the work hours as shown on the map adjacent. The **red** line shows the road closure extents, and the **blue** line shows the diversion route.

**Emergency Vehicles:** No access for emergency vehicles.

**Residents/Businesses:** Access for residents to be maintained where possible. Any residents located prior to Aldwincle turn (Fox Inn Pub) will be required to enter from the Thorpe Waterville closure point. There will be no access from Thrapston.

**Public Transport:** Bus services will not be affected.

**Parking:** To help us with our work, please move any vehicles parked within this section of the road before 08:00am. This is to enable our workforce to be able to carry out the works swiftly, without delay. We also ask that you park leaving a minimum of 20 metres of any junction for the duration of the works. Advanced 'No Parking' warning signs will be placed in the area 24 hours before. Thank you for your understanding, patience, and co-operation.

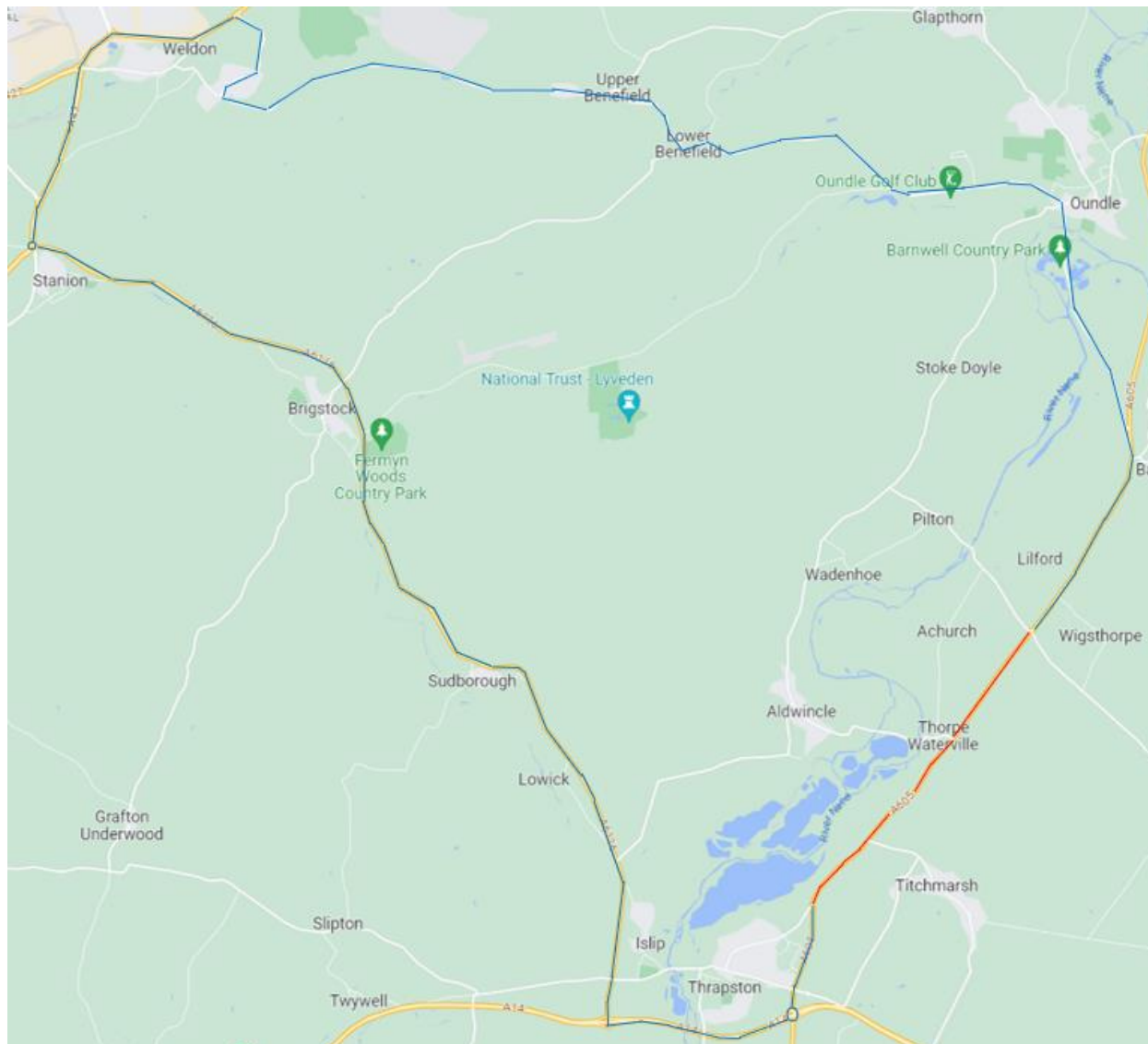
